


FAQ's About Facilitating an Explore God Discussion Group



What: A five week opportunity to connect and discuss Five Big Questions about God and life, starting the week of April 8.

1. *Is There A God?*
2. *Why Does God Allow Pain and Suffering?*
3. *Is Christianity Too Narrow?*
4. *Is the Bible Reliable?*
5. *Can I know God Personally?*

Why: To reach the Triangle by churches coming together in unity with the gospel. *Church unity is the missing apologetic (Gary Vet)*. 48 local churches are partnering, including Hope.

Tell me about facilitating an Explore God discussion group:

- Groups are about having honest conversations in a respectful environment.
- You don't have to be an expert. Just create space for open conversation. In fact, you may be learning yourself.
- Groups are for everyone. We all have questions. Invite friends, neighbors, family, co-workers. Can be 3 to 10 people.
- Groups center on watching online videos and then discussing them together using the questions provided.
- You facilitate a safe place for people of various beliefs and backgrounds to ask questions and talk.
- All resources are free online and can be streamed to any mobile device, laptop or internet capable device.
- The training (five very short videos and facilitator tips) is also online. In 30 minutes you'll know all you need to get started.
- Social media posts, e-vites, and other support materials help you get started.
- If you can invite people, serve a snack, and push play you can facilitate a group. Please pray and consider it!
- You can do a private group and invite people, or a public group at a public setting (coffee shop, etc.) and let people sign up from an online drop pin map.
